GREG HUNTER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND

INTRODUCTION	
Eligibility:	Any college-aged person may apply. The Sandia Peak Ski Patrol does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, creed or national origin in its membership, provision of services, or granting of educational assistance.
Background:	<p>In August of 1990, following the murder of Greg Hunter, the Sandia Peak Ski Patrol established and solicited public funds for a memorial educational fund to provide scholarship fund for college-aged patrollers, and other young men and women.</p> <p>The patrol provides grants directly to educational institutions (including trade and vocational schools) on behalf of the successful applicant. Funds are only provided as they are available. There is no specific monetary limit or guarantee of minimum amount. Applicants may reapply each year.</p>
Criteria:	<p>The successful applicant must have supported the Sandia Peak Ski Patrol's charitable and educational purposes which are:</p> <p><i>facilitation of the rescue of and administration of first aid to injured persons; the education and training of the patrol members in first aid, tobogganing and other necessary skills; and the promotion of skiing safety and courtesy.</i></p>

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED UNLESS THE FOLLOWING MATERIALS ARE SUBMITTED
ON OR BEFORE THE COMPLETION OF THE NM SKI SWAP.

1. Completed application (attached). An incomplete or late application may be rejected without consideration. A letter may be submitted that includes all of the requirements of the application form, instead of the application form itself.
2. A typed or word-processed essay of 500 words or less in which you discuss your professional interests, abilities and intentions, as well as any special considerations related to this application. Specifically explain how you have supported the patrol's charitable and educational purposes and why you deserve to be awarded a scholarship.
3. Three letters of recommendation (sent from originator directly to scholarship administrator). One must be from a recent teacher or instructor; another from a recent employer or volunteer supervisor. All letters must specifically address how you have supported the Sandia Peak Ski Patrols charitable and educational purposes described above.
4. The application, essay, and letters of recommendation may be submitted by email to apdonnell67@gmail.com.

Current telephone number and email addresses must be submitted to facilitate follow-up contact from the Scholarship Committee. Additional references may be required.

All applicants, whether successful or not, will be notified soon after the NM SKI SWAP of the committee's decision.
